- <sup>11</sup> On the day you stood by when strangers carried off his wealth,  
and foreigners entered into his gates,  
and cast lots on Jerusalem,  
you were just like one of them.
- <sup>12</sup> But you should not have gloated over your brother  
in the day of his disaster.  
You should not have rejoiced over the children of Judah  
in the day of their destruction.  
You should not have spoken arrogantly  
on the day of distress.
- <sup>13</sup> You should not have entered into the gate of my people  
in the day of their calamity.  
You should not have gloated over their misfortune  
in the day of their calamity.  
You should not have laid hands on their substance  
in the day of their calamity.
- <sup>14</sup> You should not have stood at the crossways,  
to cut down those trying to escape.  
You should not have handed over those who survived  
in the day of distress.
- <sup>15</sup> For the day of the LORD is near on all the nations;  
as you have done, it will be done to you;  
your deeds will return back on your own head.
- <sup>16</sup> Just as you have drunk on my holy mountain,  
so will all the nations drink continually;  
they will drink, and gulp down,  
and will be as though they had never been.
- <sup>17</sup> But in Mount Zion there will be those who escape,  
and it will be holy;  
the house of Jacob will regain its inheritance.
- <sup>18</sup> The house of Jacob will be a fire,  
and the house of Joseph a flame,  
but the house of Esau stubble.  
They will burn them up and devour them.  
There will not be a sole survivor of the house of Esau,"  
for the LORD has spoken it.
- <sup>19</sup> Those of the Negev will possess the mountain of Esau,  
and those of the Judean foothills the Philistines.  
They will possess the lands of Ephraim,  
and the lands of Samaria.

Benjamin will possess Gilead.

<sup>20</sup> This group of exiles from the descendants of Israel,  
who are among the Canaanites,  
will possess all the way to Zarephath.

The captives of Jerusalem,  
who are in Sepharad,  
will possess the towns of the Negev.

<sup>21</sup> Saviors will ascend Mount Zion to judge the Mount of Esau,  
and the kingdom will be the LORD's.
